- 25' min. tape measure
- 4 in 1 screwdriver
- 50' extension cord
- Carpenter's pencils
- Chalk line
- Circular saw with sharp blade
- Cordless multi-tool
- Hammer
- Keel
- Nail puller (cat's paw)
- Nail sets
- Pliers or dykes
- Speed square
- Tool belt or apron
- Utility knife
- Wood chisels
