- Level
- Nut drivers (1/4", 5/16", 3/8")
- Panduit gun
- Pattern snips

- Right and left aviation snips
- Sheetmetal hammer
- Sheetmetal tongs
- Square
- Straight snips-equivalent to wiss no. 18
- Tool belt or apron
- Whitney punch (set)
