- 2' or 4' level
- 25' tape measure
- 4 in 1 screwdriver
- 5-gallon bucket with handle
- 6×6 drop cloth
- Carpenter's pencils
- Caulk gun
- Chalk line
- Cordless driver drill
- Cordless Multi-Tool
- Disposable booties
- Drywall tape dispenser
- Grout Sponge
- Hammer
- Mud/spackle knife, 3" & 6"
- Nail puller (cat's paw)
- Nail sets
- Paint brushes, 1", 3" & 4"
- Pliers or dykes
- Putty knife
- Skill saw
- Speed square
- Spray texture touch-up gun
